New 2008 Garbage Schedule – A Big Success

The “New Bulk Monday Pick-Up” is designed for those of us who clean out our shed, garage, or home over the weekend and can now place their bulk items at the curb on Sunday evening for Monday pick-up. This way, no one should have to look at mattresses, refrigerators, etc. sitting on the curb for 5 days. NO garbage is to be put at the curb until **after 6:00 p.m. on the eve of pick-up day**. This is an effort to keep Islandia clean, and your compliance will be greatly appreciated by the Village and your neighbors.

Monday: (Bulk Pick-Up Day) up to six (6) garbage containers of household garbage plus up to three (3) bulk items, such as small furniture, mattresses, and appliances. You may put out up to six (6) bags of leaves OR six (6) tied bundles of brush. (NO grass clippings)

Wednesday: (WRAP) This includes glass, metal, plastic, or newspapers. (Please visit the web site or your calendar for additional information)

Thursday: (Regular Household Garbage) up to six (6) garbage containers containing household garbage ONLY.

New Recycling Campaign

A new recycling campaign is about to be launched in the Village of Islandia. New recycling receptacles are on order for each homeowner. The Village plans on involving area children in this effort, which will help to teach them about conserving natural resources and minimizing the costs for garbage disposal. 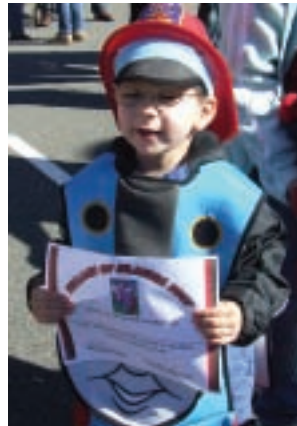
